Dear Parents/Guardians,

Woodbury Middle School is pleased to offer WEB and CAMP 6 to all incoming 6th grade students! The program will focus on transitioning from elementary to middle school through team building and cooperative group activities that span the scope of managing the lock on lockers and the layout of the school to moving through a series of rotations that will familiarize students with WMS surroundings and expectations.

We encourage all incoming sixth grade students to register no later than July 15, 2017 to secure a bus stop location in your neighborhood. If your child is unable to attend all 3 days, we encourage them to register and attend as much of the Camp 6 as possible.

What are the goals of WEB and CAMP 6?

- To minimize the transition to middle school
- To develop confidence in becoming a middle school student
- To meet new classmates from other elementary schools
- To familiarize students with the logistics of moving through the new school environment
- To be ready to learn on the first day of school, September 5th

When will the 3 day program take place?

- **August 21** - 8:00 am-12:00 pm students: WEB (Where Everybody Belongs)
- **August 22** - 8:00 am-12:00 pm students: CAMP 6
- **August 23** - 8:00 am-12:00 pm students: CAMP 6 with school pictures being taken that morning as well
- **August 29** - 6-8 pm Parent./Guardian/Student Open House

**Note: parents/guardians/students need not be present the entire evening.*

Will transportation provided?

- Transportation will be provided for the students to and from school for the morning sessions. Bus stop routes for CAMP 6 will be available on the WMS web site and will be sent via email newsletters to households in August. Please make sure your Parent Portal information is updated and current with regards to your e-mail choice to receive communications.
- Transportation will not be provided for students who are walkers or open enrollment students.

How do students register for the program?

What to bring.....

- Students do not need to bring anything on August 21st WEB Day. Just wear comfortable clothes.
