

Personal Technology

WMS is continually committed to providing the best learning environment possible for all students.



All personal electronic devices are to be turned off and secured in lockers during learning periods from 7:50-2:26.

This procedure applies to all personal cell phones, ear buds, headphones, smart watches, bluetooth speakers, and various personal electronic devices other than the school-issued chromebooks.

It is a parent/guardian(s) choice to send student(s) to school with personal electronic devices. WMS provides all students access to technology for learning during the school day.

Devices will stay in secured lockers if the device must come to school.*

***Reminder - never share a locker combination. WMS is not responsible for lost or stolen items.**

It is required that personal devices not be seen in classrooms during the school day.

Students **may** access their personal technology during lunches (excluding speakers or other noise-making devices).

If a student is found to be in violation of this procedure:

1. The personal device(s) will be confiscated by a WMS staff member and brought to the counseling office.
2. The student will receive a personal technology suspension as follows:
 - a. Personal electronic device(s) will be turned in by the student at the start of the school day in the counseling office and can be picked up at the end of the day for the length of the personal technology suspension **OR**
 - b. Parent/guardian(s) can send a signed note to the counseling office stating the device(s) will be left at home during the school day during the personal technology suspension.
 - c. Progressive levels:
 - i. First offense: 5 school days
 - ii. Second offense: 15 school days
 - iii. Third and subsequent offenses: 30 school days

Other information:
